Event Date:	Saturday, October 5th: Shopping time 8:00 AM-4:00 PM
Application Process	Prospective vendors will submit an online application for review. SI Tuscaloosa will quickly review applications to prevent overlap in vendor offerings and email accepted vendors with confirmation and instructions for payment.
Booth Size:	Standard booths are 8'x8'. Several Lobby XL booths are available for \$125. Inquire for availability.
Cost	Empty standard booth cost is \$70. Booth with one table and two chairs available for \$80. Vendors who are approved and paid by September 15th will receive table and chairs at no charge.
Set Up Time:	Friday, October 4th from 3:00-5:00 pm. and Saturday, October 5th from 7:00 AM-8:00 AM. Signage will be displayed to show vendors where they need to go.
Restrooms:	Will be available inside the Civic Center.
Break Down:	The event ends at 4:00 PM and all vendors are expected to stay set up until 4:00 PM. In addition, each vendor must remove all trash from their booth and dispose of it by 5:00 pm.
Equipment:	Access to electrical outlets is not guaranteed. We will do our best to accommodate requests. However, all vendors must provide their own equipment and extension cords if electricity is requested.
Door Prize:	Each vendor agrees to donate at least ONE (1) unwrapped item with a minimum value of \$25.00. This item will be presented at check-in. Images requested ahead of time for marketing purposes. Please include a business card.
Parking:	Immediately after unloading merchandise and before setting up displays, vendors are asked to move their vehicles to the back of the parking lot. We want the closer parking available to our customers.
Concession:	There will be food trucks and items available during the event.
